Education Business Plus Receive Confirmation of a CWEA/NWDA Funding Bid

The Project Development Team within Education Business Plus have recently received confirmation of a £280,000 funding bid to deliver an "Enterprise Culture" project over three years on behalf of the North West Development Agency (NWDA).

Christine Fryer, Team Leader Project Development explains: "Its great news. This project will enable the team to deliver enterprise activities into primary schools for the first time. Currently, funding for enterprise is only available for years 10 and 11 in high schools and we are delighted that the Cheshire & Warrington Economic Alliance have given us their full support in our application for this funding".

The project will enable Education Business Plus to work with three Business Enterprise Colleges and four of their feeder primary schools (12 primary schools in total), starting with year six and following them through to the high school into year eight. A series of workshops and challenges will help to build enterprise awareness at an early age and embed ideas of entrepreneurship.

"The whole team is excited about this project. It will be a great opportunity to embed ideas of enterprise at an early stage and build upon this through to year 8".
